Following the success of the Zoom competition last year the decision has been made that we will have another one, however the format has been changed which should make it easier to handle.

All images entered will be sent to the individual judges randomly for scoring. The collated scores will then give the Club placing. As per previous years there will be an award for best Individual image chosen by the judges from the highest scoring images.

On 13<sup>th</sup> March, via Zoom, the images will be shown, and scores announced, as if “live”.

**This event WILL be a pre-Qualifying event for the PAGB PDI Championship in 2022.**

### **RULES**

1. The competition is open to all clubs affiliated to N&EMPF.
2. All clubs wishing to compete must submit an entry by email to the organiser by **4<sup>th</sup> February 2022**
3. All competing clubs must by **13<sup>th</sup> FEBRUARY 2022**: -
  - a) Provide the organiser with a Folder, clearly labelled containing:-
    1. All 20 images
    2. The entry form filled in electronically showing the club initials, image title, name of photographer and nature ones clearly indicated.
    3. The Folder may be sent by using the website [WeTransfer.com](http://WeTransfer.com) OR on a stick in the post.
  - b) Maximum image size is 1600 pixels horizontal x 1200 pixels vertical.
4. Images projected in previous N&EMPF Club PDI or Slide Championships are not eligible.
5. All images must be labelled in the manner - The Title by An Author.jpg
6. Photographers may only represent one club of which they must be bona fide members and must be able to support that club in the event of the club competing in the national final.
7. No photographer may have more than 4 images in the Image Bank of 20.
8. No Club may have more than 6 Nature images in the Image Bank.
9. Each image will be marked 2 to 5 by each of three judges, i.e. maximum 15, minimum 6.
10. Your Total Club Score will be determined as the total score of the best 16 images.
11. The highest scoring club will be awarded the trophy to hold for one year.
12. In the event of a tie, the unused images will be added sequentially until the tie is resolved.
13. An award will be given to the author of the image judged to be the best image shown in the competition.
